This volume is a commentary to the European Succession Regulation (Regulation (EU) No. 650/2012). The Regulation is a landmark in the field of European Union private international law. It unifies the rules on conflicts of laws, jurisdiction and the recognition and enforcement of foreign judgments, and authentic instruments and court settlements, in the field of succession and wills. It also establishes a European Certificate of Succession, as an alternative to existing national certifications. This volume provides an article-by-article commentary on the individual provisions of the Regulation, introduced by a comprehensive overview of its general framework and underlying principles, authored by Angelo Davì. As a reference tool for the Regulation, this book is intended to promote a high standard of interpretation and application. With contributions from leading scholars in the field, it uses a comparative approach in its analysis to enrich the academic debate and highlight the problems likely to arise in the practical application of the Regulation.
