Doctoral Workshop on EU Law

16 - 17 March 2023

The Doctoral Workshop on EU Law welcomes PhD candidates to submit their applications for participating in an in-person meeting in Pisa. The Workshop is a two-day event (in a lunch-to-lunch format) which will take place on **16 - 17 March 2023** at the University of Pisa. The main objective of it is to give PhD candidates the opportunity to present their research to a specialised panel of discussants and receive their feedback.

<u>Jacopo Alberti</u> (University of Ferrara), <u>Graham Butler</u> (University of Aarhus), <u>Eleftheria</u> <u>Neframi</u> (University of Luxembourg), <u>Ellen Vos</u> (University of Maastricht) will act as discussants in the panels. <u>Sara Poli</u> and <u>Simone Marinai</u> (University of Pisa) will chair the panels and will contribute to the discussion.

The workshop focuses on legal issues arising from the EU's internal and external action. The call is addressed to PhD students who carry out research projects related to the role of EU agencies, or other EU organisms, within the institutional framework set out by the Treaties or to topics falling within the area of the EU's external action.



Applicants are invited to submit the following documents to doctoralworkshopunipi@gmail.com by 30 November 2022:

- Curriculum Vitae;
- A summary of your research work (including legal background, research objectives, methodology, and a short list of bibliographic references) (4000 words maximum).

The selected candidates will be asked to submit a final text (8000 words maximum) **30 days before the event** to <u>doctoralworkshopunipi@gmail.com</u>, which will be forwarded, in addition to their CVs and research summary, to the discussants. This process will guarantee enough time for the discussants to evaluate it and offer valuable comments during the Workshop.

PhD candidates may decide to submit a summary of the overall research project to be carried out to write their PhD thesis or part of this project (for example a chapter of the thesis or a specific research issue to be developed in the thesis).

Selected candidates will be notified by 12 December 2022.

An open-access publication of the works presented at the workshop will be published.

The University of Pisa will cover 1 night accommodation for the selected candidates.
