Breve descrizione

The aim of the EuPILART project is a high-profile education on the currently most interesting and innovative topic in European Private International Law. Its core goal is the establishment of an annual Winter School on European Private International Law. Its subject matter will change every year, based on the issues that can be particularly interesting under

theoretical perspectives or for the practice, or new, due to legislative innovations or case law, or modern, due to the outbreak of new social or legal need. The project will underline the importance of EPIL in and outside the EU; in particular, on third states, due to new international conventions prepared under the auspices of international organizations to which Member States and/or EU is a Member (for example, the HCCH Judgement Convention), and to the international cooperation pushed by the EU (for example, the accession of third States to the Convention on the civil aspects of international child abduction according to the CJEU Opinion 1/13). The project will raise awareness of this important field, as well as equip the Winter School participants with knowledge and skills related to EPIL, to be used in practice. The Winter School is endorsed by the European Association of Private International Law (<https://eapil.org/>), as an activity to be performed under the auspices of the association.
